WEBSEITE: Schoodic Lake Association will soon have its own website. The website will have the basic information about SLA and will be use to provide information. The big attraction will be a webcam located on the South Shore Road that will show a view of Schoodic Lake and Mt. Katahdin. Also will be adding water level monitor that will be available on the site. The address is www.schoodiclakeassoc.org.

DAM INSPECTION REPORT: The Directors contracted with Kleinschmidt Energy & Water Resource Consultant to inspection the dam at the outlet of Schoodic Lake. The complete report is available on the website. The CONCLUSSION of the report states, "The Schoodic Lake Dam is in fair to poor condition overall with the significant concern being the right embankment. The left embankment and the concrete outlet structure were in fair condition. There were no items noted that require immediate repair but there are significant repairs that will be required in the future.

NORTON POND PROJECT: SLA contacted the Town Manager of Brownville, Sophie Wilson on the current status of this project. The project is on hold due to the economy condition. SLA also contacted DEP at the Bangor to inquirer how the permitting process on a project of this size is done. It would require a great deal of work by the developer. When the project starts to move forward again DEP would be willing to do a presentation for the SLA on how the permitting process will work.

WATERSHED SURVEY REPORT: The University of Maine Cooperative Extension issued a report on Schoodic Lake dated June 2010. This report is on SLA website at schoodiclakeassoc.org. Volunteers spent many hours inspecting the areas of the watershed for soil erosion – the greatest threat to our lake. Laura Wilson form the UofMaine Cooperative Extension stated that although the report was published it may not be complete. There are some sections of the shore line that do not appear to be done. We need to complete the survey for all of the watershed so that SLA can apply for grant funds to make repairs to some of the erosion areas. If you would like to volunteer to help complete the survey please let us know, and training will be arranged.

KNIGHT'S LANDING BOAT RAMP AND ROAD: The Town of Brownville at the annual town meeting vote to take the roadway by eminent domain. Brownville has done preliminary road, drainage and boat launch design. Brownville will be working with Lake View Plantation to finalize the plans and budget. Plans to start construction in the spring or fall of 2011.

NEWSLETTER: This will be the last news letter that will be mailed. Post cards will be mail to announce the annual meeting. The annual news letter will be posted on the website. A printed newsletter will be available upon request and a stamped return envelope.

MEMBERSHIP DUES: The annual dues are \$10.

Road Associations have arranged to collect the SLA dues, ON A VOLUNTARY basis, with the road association dues. And to make this a better deal, your membership dues to SLA are reduced to \$5, instead of \$10. For example, if your road association dues are \$100 you write a check to your road association for \$105. The \$5 is not an additional road dues. The road association will forward to the SLA one check and a list of the people that have paid SLA dues. This method saves you \$5.
